United Way of Forsyth County is able to leverage each dollar invested to achieve the maximum impact in our local community. No matter how much you give, every dollar helps build our community and improve lives.

Below are examples of ways the United Way of Forsyth County maximizes the value of your dollars in our community.

\$15 per week for a year ...

...provides substance abuse counseling and assists one person to begin recovery and remain employed or in school.

\$12 per week for a year ...

... provides one week of emergency shelter for a homeless family of four, alleviating stress and helping to establish some stability.

\$10 per week for a year ...

... provides 5 foreclosure mitigation counseling sessions that would help a Forsyth County family avoid foreclosure. The cost of foreclosure on our community is over \$40,000 per home foreclosure.

\$5 per week for a year ...

... provides unemployed or underemployed individuals with career counseling, interview coaching, resume preparation, networking advice and job search support.

\$2 per week for a year ...

... provides three meals a day to a hungry family of four for two months.

\$1 per week for a year ...

... enables a young girl from a low-income family to learn character development and leadership skills.
